The fruitful tree is the family. Since the Christian family is a little Church, a miniature Mystical Body of Christ, the trunk and branches of the tree form the Chi (X) and Rho (P), the initials and symbol of Christ, the Christogram. The seven streams are the seven sacraments that bring grace to the soul.

BIRTH *Linked rings*: marriage. *Fruitful tree*: the family born of the union of the husband and wife.

BAPTISM *Fish*: the ancient symbol for a Christian. *Water*: the life-giving waters of Baptism. *Candle*: baptismal candle, given to the Christian who is to be the light of the world. *Christogram*: Christ, to whom Baptism joins the Christian.

FIRST COMMUNION *Chalice and Host*: the Body and Blood of Christ, received in the Holy Eucharist.

CONFIRMATION *Dove*: symbol of the Holy Spirit.

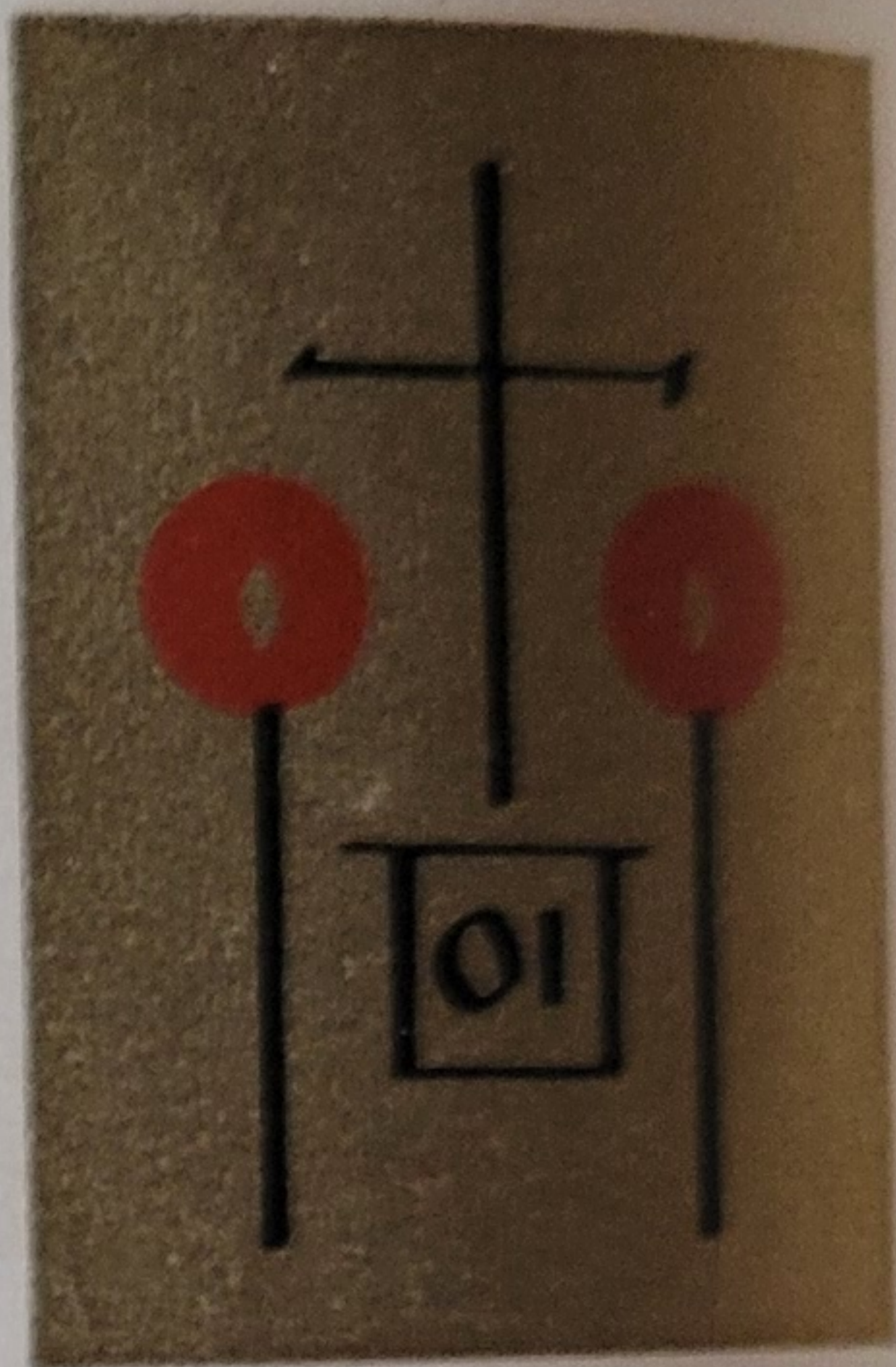
MARRIAGE *Linked Rings*: indissoluble union of husband and wife. *Cross*: union of spouses symbolizes union of Christ and His Church. *Flames*: grace of sacrament burning in souls of the spouses.

PRIESTHOOD *Book, Crook, Stole*: the triple function of Christ (Teacher, Ruler, Sanctifier) continued in His Church by the priesthood He instituted.

RELIGIOUS LIFE *Three Links*: the vows (poverty, chastity, and obedience), binding one to Christ.

LAST ANOINTING *Cross*: Christ. *Container for the Holy Oil* (Marked with the initials O.I.): The oil of the Infirm or of the Sick, used in the sacrament. *Candles*: burned during the last rites.

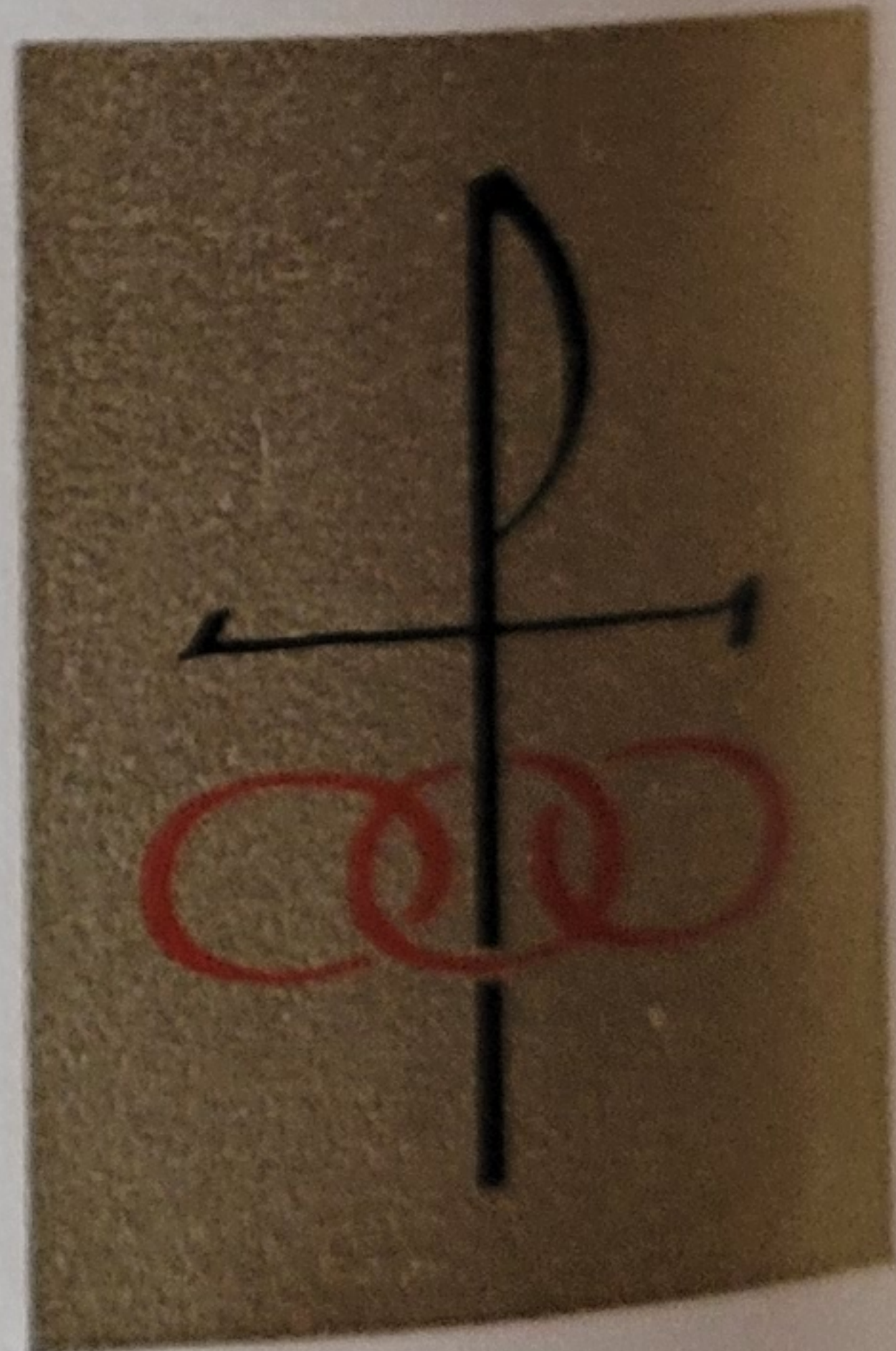
DEATH *Radiant Cross*: sign of our redemption and our hope of immortality. *Palms*: sign of victory.

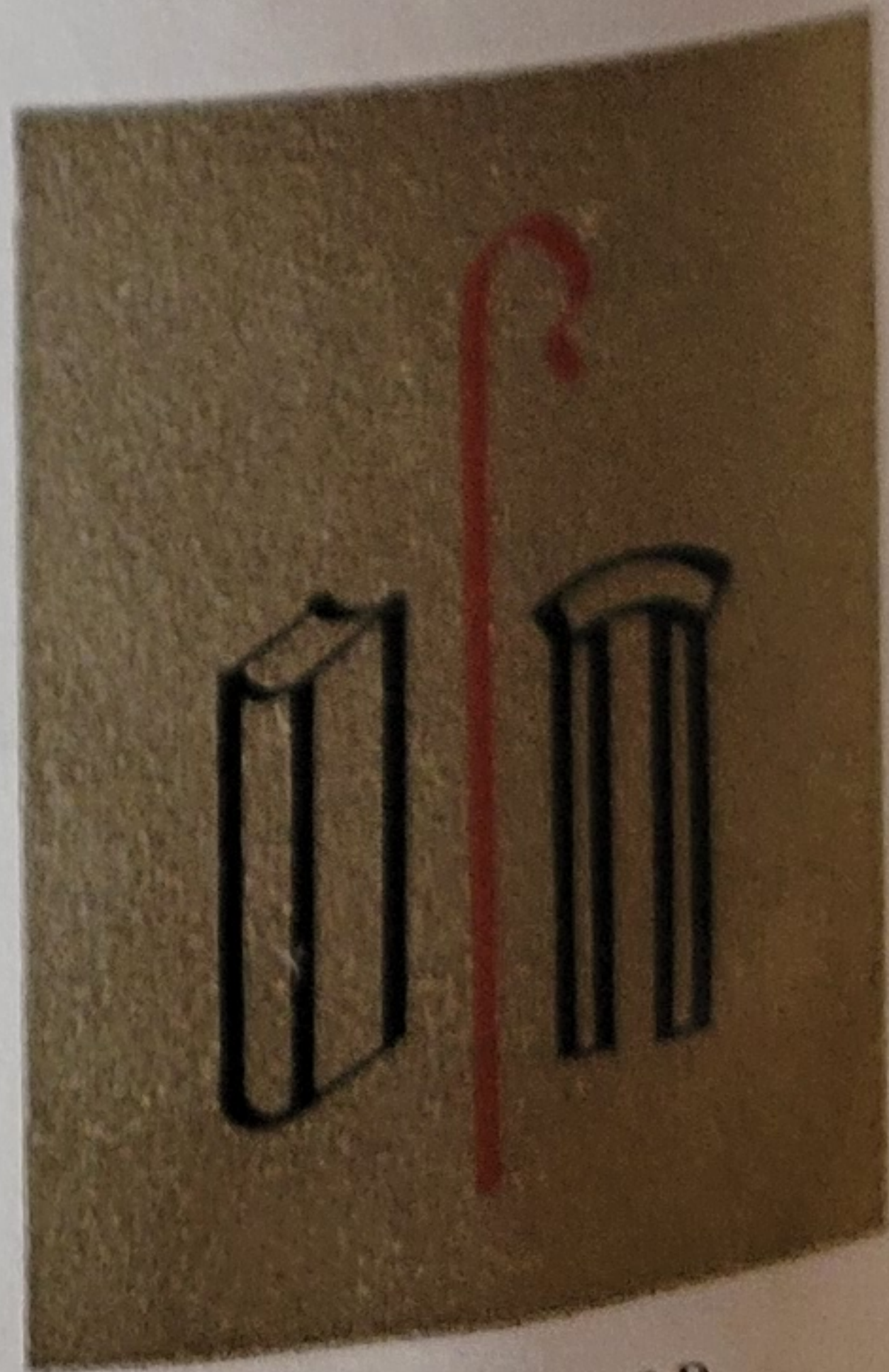
