Costa Rica was wonderful!!! The trip there wasn't bad. On the plane ride from Miami to Costa Rica Riley fell asleep on the plane right before we took off and woke up right after we landed, he asked "how come the plane still never moved?" It was really cute. After going through customs we went outside where we were greeted by a smiling face on the other side of the huge glass wall with a sign pressed up against the wall with Mom's name on it. I waved and got a super excited wave back. This was Keilor, Lindsay's (the one who runs the program) husband. With him was also our driver. The car ride there was kind of scary but we all fell asleep anyway so it was fine. When we got there everyone was very excited, especially Andres, the 4 year old boy! Everyday we had 2 hours of Spanish class, had lunch, and then did some community service. Riley was hesitant about going to his own Spanish class and kept trying to escape so the second day they did their class in the section of the room next to us, with a short wall barrier. They did art projects, learning the name in Spanish. After a couple days Riley warmed up to Dani, his Spanish teacher, also Lindsay's sister. We did vocab and conversations, I started getting better, everyone did. After a couple days Riley came and told me "Mom, my friend won't listen to my words" I tried explaining that he wasn't not listening it was just that he didn't understand them. After a couple more days he was better. By the end of our trip he started speaking some Spanish words. The first community service day we went to this old couple's house and painted all of the outside of it. The government had given them this house because they didn't have one and the old man was too sick to paint his house. They really wanted some color so we gave it to them. The second day we made sugar cane juice and had people come over and we all made soup together. We also made bracelets with the kids that were there. The third day we played with kids at the school for awhile. When we got there the beautiful girls in their folklor dresses came and greeted us, grabbing both arms and escorting us in and having us sit down. First everyone sang their national anthem and then they turned on music for us to sing our national anthem. Then the girls did some dances for us and showed us some fruits. The boys were not there because the school was out for vacation and they had to go to San Jose and work at the coffee fields. Then we played games and decorated magnets. They gave most of the ones they decorated to us. Then we went across the street and painted the front of another house and the inside room. The fourth day for most of Spanish class we went with Keilor and picked banana leaves to make tamales with. Then we went with Ligia, Lindsay's mom, into her kitchen to make the tamales. Ligia and Jose is who we stayed with. We went to the river and ate tamales and swam. Then on Saturday we went with Christian, Lindsay's brother to the volcano and the rainforest. We walked in the rainforest while it was raining. That was fabulous!!!! Christian was so great with Riley. He had Riley show us sleeping grass, he touched it and all the leaves folded up making it look like a stick. We also saw a sloth crossing the road, it moved so slow but had so much talent climbing. That was really cool. The rainforest was gorgeous and Christian really knows what he is talking about and loves his work. Then to finish off our day we went to the hot springs and had a relaxing time there. We went to La Fortuna and did a little souvenir shopping then went home and had dinner. The next morning we packed up, had breakfast,

Well that's about it. Riley and I love you guys very much!

As you come off any of the freeways,
look for the Sail Boat sign
to direct you to Jack London Square.

From North of Oakland: From Interstate 80, take Interstate 880 to Alameda-San Jose exit, (third lane from left), follow along I-880 to the Broadway-Alameda exit, ease right at bottom of ramp, take first right on Adeline, go one block, take first right on Adeline, left on 3rd, go 12 blocks, turn right on Broadway, follow Broadway into Jack London Square.

From Contra Costa County: Highway 24 to Interstate 980/Downtown Oakland (careful not to get on 580 toward Hayward). Take the 11th - 12th Street exit, straight on Brush Street, (you will be parallel with the freeway) Take a left on 3rd, right on Broadway, follow Broadway into Jack London Square.

From South of Oakland: Interstate 880 North to the Broadway exit. Take a left on Broadway, follow Broadway into Jack London Square.

The Historic Side of Jack London Square

A Brief History

Imagine the 1800's along Oakland's thriving waterfront.

1 Ships coming in to dock, smaller sailing vessels racing up and down the Estuary, seagulls screeching and the voice of Jack London singing a sailor's song or spinning yarns for the pleasure of those around him. The history

of this area, now known as Jack London Square, dates back to the gold rush days when twice-weekly ferry service between San Francisco docked at the foot of Broadway in Oakland. In 1852, when the State Legislature incorporated the Town of Oakland, the first meeting of the Board of Town Trustees was held here. Today, Jack London Square is a complex of office buildings, restaurants, shop, hotels and a 139-berth marina. Important destinations now line the open pedestrian walkways: Barnes & Noble Bookstore, Jack London Cinema, Yoshi's World Class Jazz House, the Waterfront Plaza Hotel, along with 14 restaurants



thirst for adventure. World-renowned author of over fifty books including "White Fang," "The Sea-Wolf" and "The Call of the Wild," Jack London spent many hours in the tavern during his youth. He began by selling newspapers from a barstool at age ten to seafarers while he collected tales of the sea that he would later

include in some of his most famous works. **2** Bar owner Johnny Heinold befriended the young Jack and invited him to come in out of the weather to study the large Webster's dictionary he bought for him. **3** It was Johnny who loaned Jack the money to purchase his first small sailboat and to attend the University of California. Although he didn't stay long at the college, Jack soon began writing. Johnny Heinold and the First and Last Chance Saloon are referred to dozens of times in London's novels, "John Barleycorn" and "The Tales of the Fish Patrol."

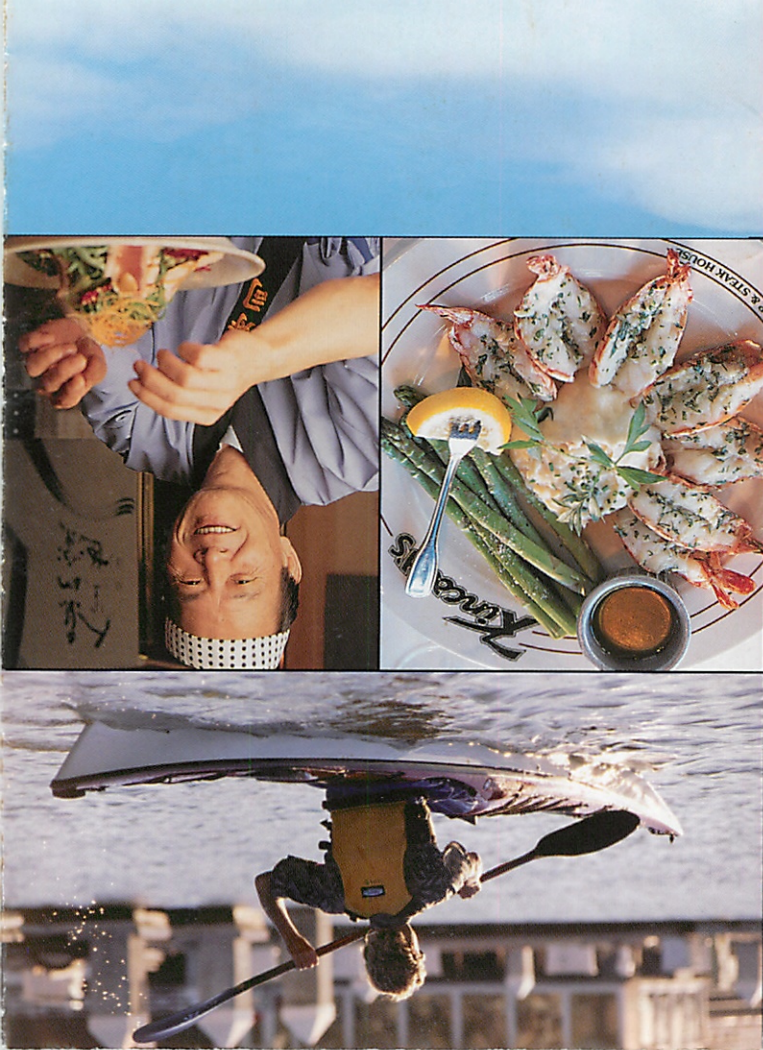

known as the First and Last Chance in the 1920's as the first and last place to get a drink from the Oakland end of the Alameda Ferry. In January of 1998, Heinold's was named as a *National Literary Landmark* by the Friends of the Library, USA. In September of 2000, Heinold's was added to the National Registry of Historic Places.

History Walk

Take a look at the distinctive wolf tracks at your feet as you make your way around the Square. As you follow them you will discover the history of the area listed on diamond-shaped historic markers highlighting facts about Jack London, the Port of Oakland, the waterfront, and the City of Oakland.



Begin your walk at Heinold's First and Last Chance Saloon, in continuous operation at its location since 1883. Go further along the tracks to a life size statue of Jack London standing watch over the waterfront at the foot of Broadway. Next to the statue is the site of the first ferry service and the transfer point for the Pony Express to San Francisco. At the far end of the Square is the Presidential Yacht Potomac, FDR's "Floating White House." While not a part of the original history of the waterfront, the former Coast Guard cutter is permanently berthed at Jack London Square after being lovingly restored to its original glory. Dockside tours are available year round and historic bay cruises depart seasonally. **4** All of the bronze wolf tracks and historic markers are sponsored by individuals and organizations in our community.
